Second Half of the Shāhnāmeh of Ferdowsi

A complete manuscript of high quality containing 232 folios measuring 35.3 x 24 cm. that constitute the second half of the *Shāhnāmeh*. Another volume that constitutes the first half of the epic is in the collection of Prince Sadruddin Aga Khan, in Geneva (Ms. C). The text is written in good *nasta'liq* in four columns, twenty-five lines per page. There is one double page illuminated frontispiece (ff.1v and 2), and twenty-one miniature paintings, all signed by Mo'in Moṣavver, which are for the most part clever solutions to unique compositional problems.
